The **FIRST PARTY** and the **SECOND PARTY**, hereinafter referred to in this Cooperation Agreement as the **PARTIES**.

The **PARTIES** agree to conduct a Cooperation Agreement, following the provisions referred to in these articles.

**Article 1  
Main Task**

FIRST PARTY and SECOND PARTY appropriately implement the Cooperation of Implementation of *Tridharma Perguruan Tinggi* and Freedom of Learning Independent Campus Program (*MKBK*)

**Article 2  
Objective**

1. The Cooperation Agreement is aimed at supervising management aspects of the utilization of human resources, facilities, and infrastructure in this cooperation.
2. Developing institutions and increasing quality, including expertise, both parties

### **Article 3**

#### **Scope**

1. Implementation of cooperation includes activities:
  - a. Volunteer teaching staff for English and other foreign language teaching team.
  - b. Research and Community Service.
  - c. Local Internship for students (1-12 months).
  - d. Visiting Professor and Lecturer Exchange.
  - e. International Fieldwork (KKL).
  - f. International Community Service is available as a short-term volunteer or work camp (2-3 weeks), a midterm volunteer (1-4 months), and a long-term volunteer (5-12 months).
  - g. International Bilateral upon Request (1-2 weeks).
2. The procedure for implementing cooperation was arranged by BOTH PARTIES.

### **Article 4**

#### **Rights and Obligations**

1. **BOTH PARTIES** are entitled to:
  - a. Obtain human resources support, facilities, and infrastructure from BOTH PARTIES on the implementation of cooperation activities.
  - b. Become a partner in the development of community service and the Freedom of Learning Independent Campus program.
  - c. Obtain a continuous report update from BOTH PARTIES on the evaluation of the outcome of the cooperation activities implementation.
2. **BOTH PARTIES** obliged:
  - a. Provide human resources support, facilities, and infrastructure to BOTH PARTIES for the implementation of cooperation activities.
  - b. Arrange schemes of implementation of cooperation activities that should be implemented together.
  - c. Provide a continuous report update from BOTH PARTIES on the evaluation of the outcome of cooperation activities implementation.

### **Article 5**

#### **Fund**

Any funds for the implementation of these activities should be arranged according to the detailed program that was agreed upon by BOTH PARTIES, which should be determined regarding the financial estimate and ability of BOTH PARTIES.

### **Article 6**

#### **Period of Time**

Cooperation Agreement valid for **5 (five)** years since signed by BOTH PARTIES.

### **Article 7**

#### **Conflict Solution**

Assuming that there would be arguments or misunderstandings in this Cooperation Agreement, BOTH PARTIES agree to find the solution deliberately.

## **Article 8**

### **Force Majeure**

1. Coercive circumstances mean (hereinafter referred to as "*Force Majeure*") the circumstances that occur beyond **BOTH PARTIES** ability, failure, including authority, and cause **PARTY** that encounter is not able to implement or forced to postpone the implementation of obligations in this Agreement. *Force Majeure* includes catastrophes, floods, plagues, wars, rebellions, riots, general strikes, wildfires, or offensives from other **PARTIES** against the product of cooperation outcomes and government policies that affect directly the implementation of this Agreement;
2. In the *Force Majeure* incident, a **PARTY** that interferes in implementing the obligations is not able to be accused by any other **PARTY**. **PARTY** that encounters *Force Majeure* must inform other **PARTIES** about the *Force Majeure* incident as late as 15 (fifteen) days in the calendar after the incident occurs, along with a statement letter from an authority official that clarifies the incident that occurred. **PARTY** that encounters *Force Majeure* is obliged to attempt the implementation of the obligation as arranged in this Agreement immediately after the *Force Majeure* incident;
3. Presuming that the *Force Majeure* incident occurs continuously or that the **PARTY** that encounters *Force Majeure* will exceed 30 (thirty) days of the calendar, both **PARTIES** agree to consider the period of time of this Agreement.
4. Every disadvantage and cost from one of the **PARTIES** as the cause of the *Force Majeure* incident is the responsibility of each **PARTY**.

## **Article 9**

### **Correspondence**

Every letter or announcement that must be conducted by one **PARTY** to the other **PARTY** in the implementation of this Agreement must be conducted in writing and informed directly or through email to:
